- *Fraudulent rental home listings*
- *Offers of “free” trips*
- *Fake airline websites that sell non-existent tickets*

Tips for avoiding travel-related cyber scams:

- Research the reputation of any company you haven't dealt with before, prior to making a purchase
- Don't assume an ad or website is safe just because you see familiar brands
- Be cautious with any advertised travel deals that seem too good to be true
- Never click on links in an email or download attachments, unless you're certain it's safe
