

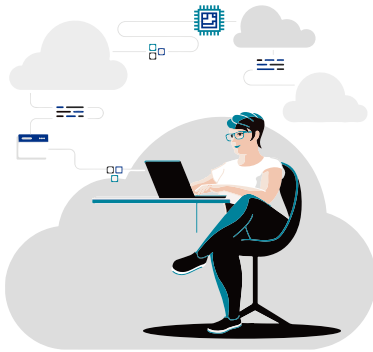

- **Program Includes** : All content for [Red Hat Systems Administrator 1 \(RH124\)](#) and [Red Hat Systems Administrator 2 \(RH134\)](#). Red Hat Online Learning access for each student including cloud hosted textbooks and hands-on labs.
- **Program Goal** : This training pathway is designed to cover core system administration tasks with the goal of training someone with minimal Linux experience to being a fully capable Linux administrator.
- **Instructor Support**: Red Hat Online Learning instructor access including access to the Video Classroom with recorded lectures for instructors to prepare to teach the content. Instructor guide is also included.
- **Certification** : Upon completion, students may be prepared for the [Red Hat Certified System Administrator exam \(EX200\)](#). An EX200 Exam Voucher is included in program cost.
- **Audience**: Anyone looking to gain the skills and knowledge necessary for an entry-level linux admin role. No experience required.
